



Important Rules to Remember at the Community Service Booth of the Beaverton Farmers' Market.

Greetings to all of our friends working the Community Service booth of the BFM! Saturdays are both hectic and fun, come well rested and prepared. If you have questions or are confused about the set up of your booth space, ask almost anyone to point you towards Ginger or Sue and we will be happy to help you. Generally you will find us near the Market's white equipment trailer (across from Key Bank) in the morning, or you can find us through the Market information Booth during the day. We won't be able to answer any questions regarding your bakery order or its delivery, but we can help with most other things.

While you are at the Market there are some important things you need to know (at this point you are considered a "vendor"):

1. Please be quiet and considerate of our neighbors when arriving and setting up in the morning. Avoid slamming car doors and tent poles. Back-up beepers on trucks are not permitted. We do not want complaints from our neighbors.
2. All vendors and their employees shall park in the vendor parking lot on 6th and Watson or on the streets south of, not including, 5th St. As tempting as it will be to park on 4th St., in front of the Methodist Church, it is not allowed. This is parking for church functions only!
3. Any product sampling for customers must be done in compliance with the guidelines specified by the ODA Food Safety Division. (see "Farmers' Market Guidelines, Minimum Requirements for Food Safety" booklet)
4. The sidewalk behind your space must remain clear and free of boxes or other paraphernalia.
5. Vendors must clean up their spaces after market and haul their garbage and unsold product home. Market trashcans and dumpster are strictly for use by Market staff for the purpose of disposing of trash left by our customers. Vendors must take their trash with them at the end of market.
6. You may not drive in or out of the market after 7:45 a.m. or before 1:45 p.m.
7. All of the items you have for sell must have clearly posted prices.
8. You may not sell, anything, before the 8:00 bell to the general public. (Selling to other vendors is OK.).
9. Make sure that the price of all of the items you have for sell is clearly marked.
10. Canopies must be secured at all times. Flying canopies cause injury to people and damage to property. We will provide you with canopy weights. If we forget - please remind us and someone from our staff will bring them to your booth.
11. There is no vendor smoking on Market grounds.

12. Please have a box or container for recycled cans - it is good for you and the environment.
13. Be enthusiastic salespeople! If you sit in a chair reading a book customers will pass you by.
